

3559 CANOVA VERTICALE TRASPARENTE

TRANSPARENT THIXOTROPIC EPOXY MASTIC







Description and Use

Two-component mastic, for application to vertical surfaces, featuring strong adhesion properties and good weathering resistance.

Especially suitable for outdoor work on granite, marble and stone.

Substrate preparation

Surfaces to be treated must be dry, clean, dust free, without grease or wax traces.

Application

Application method:

- by spatula

Product preparation:

stir thoroughly the two components, according to the recommended ratio; catalyse limited quantities of product, in order to avoid a quick reaction ("mass effect").

It is suggested 200-250 gr for each catalysis.

The complete hardening and the maximum chemical resistance will be reached after 7 days.



Storage life

If stored in a cool, dry place, away from sources of heat and sheltered from sunlight, in its sealed original packaging, the product has a shelf life in months specified in the table of products with expiry date. Check the product's shelf life by referring to the production batch number shown on the packaging. The batch number is made of eight numeric characters in which the first four digits identify the year and month of production. Once the product has expired, it must be disposed of in accordance with the current legislation.
